DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GENERAL: This insecticide is designed for use undiluted in ULV Aerosol Generators (foggers) that produce particles in an acceptable ultra-low volume droplet size range. It can be diluted with a deodorized base oil and applied in conventional fogging equipment that produce aerosol particles in a larger than ultra-low volume droplet size range. It can also be diluted with the oil specified and applied as a contact spray to kill crawling insects specified on this label. Do not apply while food processing is underway.

SPACE SPRAY:

UNDILUTED IN ULV AEROSOL GENERATORS, TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, FLEAS, SMALL FLYING MOTHS AND GNATS. Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 10 mL of undiluted Concentrate per 100 m³ of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upwards towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

UNDILUTED IN ULV AEROSOL GENERATORS, TO KILL COCKROACHES, SPIDERS AND OTHER CRAWLING INSECTS. Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air-conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 20 mL of undiluted Concentrate per 100 m³ of space. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

DILUTED FOR CONVENTIONAL FOGGING EQUIPMENT, TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS AND GNATS. Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air-conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate to 29 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 200 mL dilute spray per 100 m³ of space. Direct fog upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

CONTACT SPRAY: Diluted for use with sprayers that give large wetting spray particles to kill cockroaches and accessible stages of granary insects, weevils, flour beetles, meal moth larvae and adults, cadelles, grain mites and sawtoothed grain beetles. Cover or remove exposed food and close room as described above. Dilute concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part concentrate to 29 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside walls of grain bins, flooring, about base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harbourages using 16 L of spray per 100 m² of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat application as necessary.

CAUTION: In meat packaging and food processing plants, only spray when plant is not in operation. No exposed food products, ingredients, or packaging materials to be left in the room. Cover all food processing surfaces and food handling equipment. Any treated surfaces that may contact meat food products or other food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use for food processing. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if inhaled, swallowed, or absorbed through skin. Avoid inhalation of, or contact with the spray. Keep children away from the spray. Wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feeds, foodstuffs, milking utensils and water supplies. Wear a mask or respirator when applying spray mist. Wear protective clothing. Do not spray closer than 1 metre to fabric. Do not spray on plastic or varnished surfaces. Do not treat dairy barns. Do not apply to pastures occupied by dairy animals. Do not apply to food crops. Do not spray into or near open flame. Highly toxic to bees. This product contains a petroleum distillate which is moderately to highly toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid contamination of aquatic systems during application. Do not contaminate these systems through direct application, disposal of waste or cleaning equipment. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

FIRST AID: If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
